<b>Description</b>	The archive consists of six declarations ( <i>apographai</i> ) of house property, dated in year 14 of Philopator (209 BC). The preserved dates all point to the month Phaophi. All declarations are preserved in the Cairo museum and have been inventoried around the same time (before 1902), which suggests that they come from a single find, possibly from mummy cartonnage from Gurob. They are addressed to Apollonios, the <i>epimeletes</i> of the Arsinoite nome ( <i>Pros. Ptol.</i> I and VIII 933). As far as can be ascertained the houses declared are all situated in Mouchis, a village in the meris of Polemon. It remains therefore possible that this archive was not kept by Apollonios in the nome capital Krokodilopolis, but by an unknown official in Mouchis.
